


Important Clinic Changes from 15 December 2021

On 15 December, the Tasmanian borders will open. We will make some changes in our clinics to help keep our patients and staff as safe as possible.

Here's how we will ask you to help:

- Please wear a **surgical mask** (not a fabric mask). We will provide you with a surgical mask if you don't already have one. Surgical masks are blue or green single-use masks that look like this  →
- You will be asked to confirm your **vaccination status**. Unvaccinated patients, or patients who have only received one dose, will initially be offered a telehealth appointment. To confirm you are fully vaccinated, you will need to show one of the following when you come for your appointment:
 - Vaccination certificate (hard copy print out OR digital copy OR immunization history statement)
 - The green vaccination tick on your Check in Tas app
- Some appointments will be provided as **telehealth** or part telephone, part face to face. We will let you know how your appointment will be provided when you book.
- Please **stay in your car** when you arrive for your appointment and your doctor or nurse will call you on your mobile to start the appointment. If you don't have a car or a mobile phone, please come to reception. If you need to complete new patient paperwork, please come to reception.
- Please bring a **maximum of one person** if needed for support. Please don't bring any children.
- Please **check in** using the Check In Tas app, **sanitise** your hands, **answer COVID screening questions** honestly and **maintain social distancing** of 1.5m.
- Don't attend an in-person appointment if you are **unwell** or are **required to quarantine** or isolate. Please call us if this applies to you.
