Services at our clinics in Glenorchy, Launceston and Burnie

Contraception including:

- · IUD (Mirena, Kyleena, Copper) inserts
- Implanon in one appointment (no need to take a prescription to the chemist)
- Depo injections
- · Contraceptive pill
- Vasectomy and tubal ligation (sterilization) referrals

Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) tests and treatment

Cervical Screening Tests

Women's health and gynaecology including:

- · Period problems
- · Vulval and vaginal problems
- · Pelvic pain
- Menopause
- Prolapse and incontinence including ring pessary fitting and changeover
- Breast checks
- Fertility and pre-pregnancy
- · Post-natal checks

Pregnancy options including:

- Pregnancy testing
- · Pregnancy counselling
- · Medication termination (abortion)
- · Referrals for surgical termination

Men's health including:

- · STI tests
- Sexual dysfunction
- Testicular checks
- · Vasectomy referrals
